WARNING TO PHONE AP USERS! SCANNER PHONE APS USED WHILE MOBILE ARE JUST AS ILLEGAL AS A SCANNER IN THE MOBILE-SCANNER-REGULATED STATES! (05/26/2011) - Yes. You heard right. Apparently the same laws which regulate mobile scanner usage ALSO apply to phone applications that are available which allow users to monitor local police frequencies. While your phone itself is not technically a "scanner", some states see the use of the application as effectively turning the phone INTO one. If you don't have a ham license, or some form of permission slip, or some other form of exemption, be forewarned that those scanner aps COULD lead you into trouble! [More Here...](#)
